
SUBJECT:

In reading over, it will be of some interest to you to note the next to the last paragraph regarding our mutual friend, Smith, of Columbus, Ohio.

Fire Marshal Joe Flynn of Maine called me yesterday, saying that he had a report from the Columbus, Ohio Fire Marshal's Office concerning Segee. I told him I did not know whether you had a copy of that report, and he offered to have it copied and mailed to you by air mail, special delivery. I did not see it in this morning's mail.

He states that the report indicates that Segee, known as "Little Bob", was with the Ringling Circus between June 30, 1944 and July 13, 1944, and was with them during the Hartford fire, working for Whitey Versteen, who is still with the Circus. Also that Segee had a friend named "Danny" who died in the fire. The Circus will be playing in Wallingford Thursday, June 15, and in New London, Friday, June 16.
