Dear Judge Radcliff:

Re: Robert Segee

This is with reference to the above named young man who was committed to this hospital from your court on July 7, 1950, for 60 days mental observation, provided by Section 13451-20 G. D. and who prior to the expiration of the first commitment was given a further extension of 60 days.

Segee has not revealed any abnormal behavior while under our scrutiny and has made a very good adjustment in the hospital. He is a poorly educated person and we find that his general intelligence falls somewhat below the normal range. We regard him as being essentially neurotic and the nature of his neurosis is that of a compulsive state.

With respect to fires, he manifests some sexualization, but does not present a true perversion. Because of the type of his neurosis we feel that he is capable of committing serious crimes such as setting fires, etc.

The mental examination is otherwise negative, so that it is our opinion that Segee is neither psychotic, mentally deficient, nor psychopathic.

You may have your officers return him to Pickaway County any time.
