




concealed confession of his first killing—in 1938 of a 9-year-old girl—is this drawing by Segee of a man preparing to throw girl's body into water. Segee first told psychiatrists he was in tree (circle) watching murder, later admitted there were no trees at the scene and that he himself had killed girl by hitting her with a rock. To bolster his belated confession Segee then drew picture at left to represent more clearly his own face.



UNVERIFIED CONFESSION purports to show choking of Japanese boy for which Segee claims he stood trial while with army of occupation in 1949.



confirmed confession is this sketch by Segee showing him grappling with watchman who surprised boy as he set fire to a warehouse in Portland, Maine in March 1943. Segee's version places killing at waterfront. Actually firemen found the watchman's body inside the warehouse. Right: Segee reveals hatred for watchman by giving him surly expression. Two years before, Segee had strangled Maine lad who "had talked mean" to him.
