He will also be missed greatly by his eight grandchildren. Roger was a proud member of the Enfield Rotary Club and enjoyed many years with the Enfield Choral Society & Goldtones. He loved his family, music, travel, playing bridge and skiing. His humor, kindness and wonderful voice will be missed by all who knew him.
