#### THE CIRCUS BALLET MASTER OF THE AIR

Vanner Barbette, aerial director of Ringling Bros and Barnum & Bailey, got his first glimpse of the circus in his native Texas town on his ninth birthday. Twenty-four hours later he had fallen off his mother's clothesline attempting to imitate the wire walking stunts he had witnessed the day before.

Mr. Barbette, always the persistent type, kept trying and after several years in vaudeville as a topflight aerialist went to England and the Continent, where he appeared in variety theatres throughout Europe and eventually realized his lifelong ambition when he was engaged by the Cirque Royal at Brussels. Then followed several seasons in Continental circuses, including the famous Olympia in London.

Three years ago, Mr. Barbette joined The Greatest Show on Earth as director of aerial displays and his inspirational innovations in aerial ballets have been sensational. The beautiful Cloud Ballet of the 1944 performance is, without doubt, the greatest achievement in mass aerial presentation ever witnessed and speaks volumes for the coaching ability of Vander Barbette.

Hitherto, such group displays by ballet girls were confined to the simpler feats in aerial work, but in just three months of intensive rehearsals at winterquarters in Sarasota, Florida, sixty girls were taught the complete routines of renowned stars who have made the cloud swing famous.

To an elephant, the main course of the day's repast is hay. Of course, they do have a side dish of mash, made of seven pounds of bran, and not being particular about their figures, have found much added enjoyment in the peanuts fed them by visitors between meals. This menu of hay, bran-mash and peanuts is duly washed down by some fifty or more gallons of water daily.

"Hay-burners", is the term applied to these huge animals by circus men, but while elephants are willing to work and perform many hours of the day, just for a bale of hay . . . there is no telling what they would not do for tobacco . . . they love it, contrary to the old fable.

It is the Asiatic elephant that predominates in the circus, as the African species does not respond to training as well. But there is no difference in the matter of their appetites.

A veritable symbol of the American circus, the elephant today holds the affections of the public just as it did in George Washington's time, when it was a newcomer in this country. For, what would the circus be without elephants?

With innovations and modernization of the transportation system of a circus, even today, when the rains come and the gaudy wagons bog down in the muddy mire and man-made motors fail to respond to the terrific pull, the faithful elephant is brought forth and with head bent to the effort, the balky truck or wagon is soon on its way again.

Elephants are not cheap. The original purchase price runs into the thousands and the upkeep is tremendous. Much of the hay fed to the "bulls" on the Big Show is especially grown and cultivated at the Ringling Bros and Barnum & Bailey farm at Peru, Indiana and shipped to Winterquarters at Sarasota during the winter months. But the hay consumed during the circus season is bought locally wherever the circus might be playing.



#### GIRLS TRAIN WITH SANDBAGS

THEY DO IT with sandbags.

Yes, that's how the Reynolds and Donegan Pyramid skating girls, six pretty acrobatic and adagio dancing whirlwinds on roller skates, gain the strength to spin dizzily with other girls swinging horizontally from their necks. In practice, the girls use 80 pound sandbags, whirling them at arms' length before trying it with their partners.

The girls attain terrific speed in all their astounding feats awheel on the stages of the Ringling Bros

and Barnum & Bailey Circus and they named their act because of the pyramids they build while swiftly skating. Climbing up on one another's shoulders, they form two and three high groups, which are tricks that could climax any thrill act, but which are by no means the top feats of these remarkable young artists. They prefer their tangle-foot and diving tricks and circus-goers marvel at the tremendous speed they achieve.

and carpenter shops, canvas storage warehouse, truck repair shop, seat department and many others. Across from these was the largest building on the 200 acres of circus wonderland. This structure housed part of the menagerie on the ground floor and on the second floor was the famous Ringling sail loft where each year the largest tent in the world is made and the forty other canvas spreads required by the circus.

We visited the sail loft presided over by Ralph Harding and there, amid thousands of yards of canvas—it requires 74,000 yards a year to equip the circus and 70 miles of rope—I saw a couple of dozen veteran sailmakers working on the big top itself.

Enough canvas to cover 12 full acres of land is used. Enough sailmakers' thread and twine to stretch across the United States. Eighty-five hundred man hours are consumed in constructing the big top alone, and it seats 11,000 persons!

A trip down the elevator brought me to the vast menagerie on the ground floor. Outside there was a large pool of hippopotami. A short distance away, looking pensively over high iron fences were Soudana, the tallest giraffe in captivity, and her mate.

We next strolled over to a large tent which houses the air-conditioned cage of Mr. and Mrs. Gargantua the Great. I am sorry not to be able to report much progress on their highly publicized love affair.

Only a few steps away was the elephant kraal where I met my old friends, fifty of these huge goodnatured beasts. Some of them were being put through their routine of tricks in a regular size ring by the elephant boss, Eddie Allen.


In the mechanical department I met William Yeske, famous master mechanic, whose family for three score years has built wagons and equipment for the Big Show.

Though the folks back home in the North were shivering with the icy blasts of winter, it was real summertime here at circus Winterquarters and hundreds of visitors were coming and going in gay holiday mood. I was reminded of the spirit which permeates the air on circus day when the show is on tour.

And I learned something I had never before realized. I was one of those thousands who believed that circuses "just happened" or, like Topsy, "just grew." To me the sights I had witnessed at Ringling Bros and Barnum & Bailey Winterquarters had been the greatest performance of The Greatest Show on Earth.

#### ANIMAL TRAINING IS JUST PATIENCE

W ITHOUT gun fire or fireworks. Alfred Court, Europe's greatest wild animal trainer, is presenting his three famous mixed groups of lions, tigers, black leopards, Polar bears, Himalayan bears, jaguars, pumas, cougars and Great Dane dogs as the sensational feature of the Ringling Bros and Barnum & Bailey Circus.

Never before have so many different species of jungle, plain and forest creatures performed together in this or any other country, and everywhere one hears this query, "How does he do it?"

Let Alfred Court tell it: "Training starts when the animal is young. Training is just patience, flattery,

knowledge, courage and more patience. To train wild animals you must first of all train yourself. You must discipline yourself to endless patience and repetition. You must, like a boxer, completely submerge temper. Anger has no part in training animals.

"The first step is to teach the animal its name. Then each is taught to sit quietly on its pedestal. Each recognizes his own name, and that is the start of routine. When my whip curls through the air, the animal watches it. I call out 'Rajah' or 'Pasha', and, as my whip cracks over a particular spot, the pupil knows that I want him to take position on that spot."
